

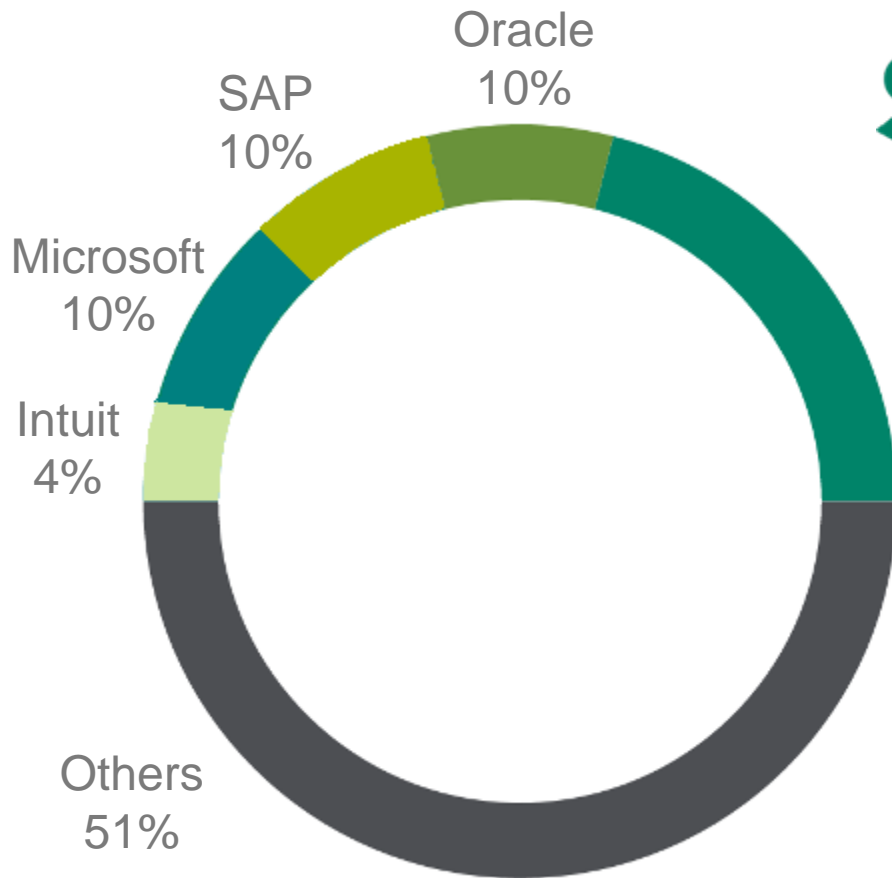

  - Focus on enhancements to advanced manufacturing/distribution
  - Reduce impact of upgrades on customizations

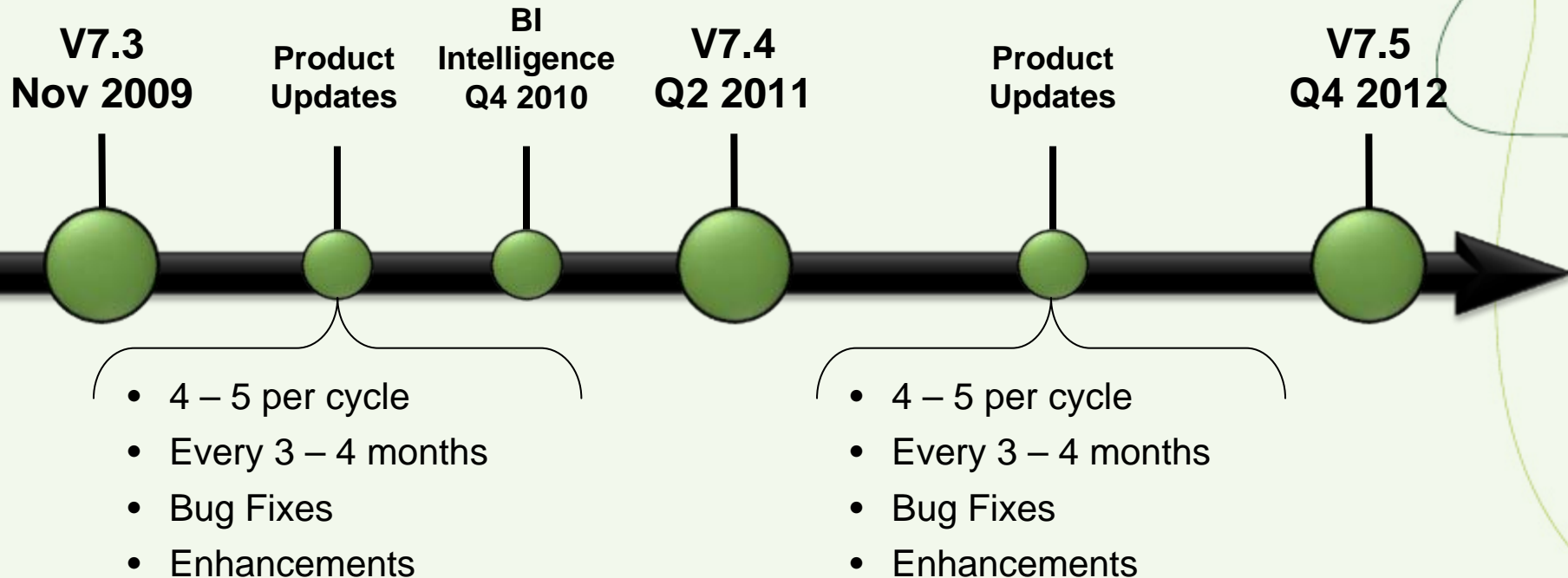

# 7.3 – Product Updates

- Product Update 1 (Dec. 2009)
  - Windows 7 support and logo certification
  - Year end tax updates
  - Fail Safe Registration: Change expiration behavior to permit continued usage without re-registering
  - General maintenance
- Product Update 2 (Feb. 2010)
  - Warn of Duplicate PO# in Sales Order Entry
  - New Security Event: Change Sales Order to Quote
  - General maintenance
- Product Update 3 (May 2010)
  - Smart Updates: Bypass update of components that are already current
  - New Security Event: Enter/edit Surcharge Amount on Transfer Orders
  - General maintenance

# 7.3 – Product Updates

## Future Enhancements

- Smart Updates
  - Warn of risk to specific customized components
  - Automatic updates to client
- Copy Sales Orders and Quotes to New Customer
- Sub-ledger Option to Warn or Fail when Post Date is outside of Current Period
- New Security Events
  - Delete Sales Order, Purchase Order
- Fail-Safe Registration
  - Simplify or remove existing server-side component
  - Resolve SQL Server permissions

# Q4 2010 – Business Insights Intelligence

- New advanced analytics and advanced financial reporting as an alternative to FRx
  - FRx supported by Microsoft until Dec 31, 2012
  - Sage MAS 500 7.4 will maintain backward compatibility with FRx
- Complex reporting and analysis in a familiar Microsoft Excel interface
- Quick Access to Business Critical Information
- BI Intelligence Application and Single-User License Bundled (Free) with version 7.4
  - FRx users can trade-in add-on FRx licenses for equivalent BI Intelligence licenses

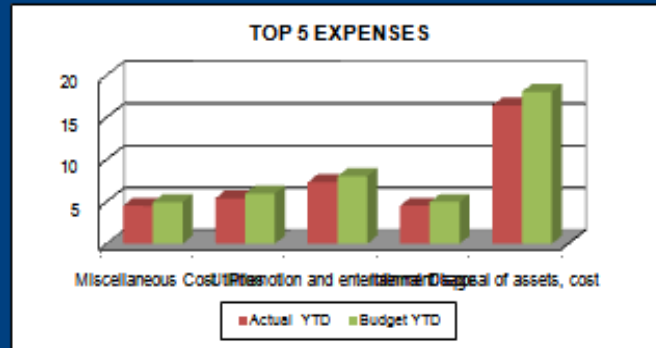

# 7.4 - Productivity Enhancements

- Track Overpayment of Invoices
- Customer Refunds
- Support Negative Line Items
  - Sales Order
  - Purchase Order
- Automated Clearing House (ACH) Extensions
  - ACH Addendum
  - ACH Remittance Advice



## 7.4 - Manufacturing and Distribution

- Allow change of preferred vendor for replenishment
- Use transaction date as post date for manufacturing transactions
- Complete work orders without issuing material
- Backflush from bin-tracked warehouse
- Enable progress reversals
- Improve Landed Cost



## 7.4 - Unit of Measure

- Improve accuracy of unit of measure conversions
- Allow reporting in alternate units of measure



## 7.4 – Platform and Performance

- Crystal 2008 (v12)
- Microsoft Office 2010
- Improve Business Insights Explorer performance
- Update third-party controls
- Visual Studio 2010 and .Net Framework 4.x
- Operating System and SQL Server Service Packs

# Sage MAS 500 7.5

- **Productivity Enhancements**
  - Track miscellaneous cash receipts' visibility in AR
  - GL renumber / merge utility
  - One-Step Invoicing
  - Allow RMA without returning to stock
  - Add customer “on-the-fly” in Sales Order
  - Expand availability of user-defined fields
  - Print preview for SO, PO and Invoice
- **Advanced Manufacturing Improvements**
  - Support use of non-inventory items
  - Allow reversal of remaining material for partially progressed
  - Backflush setup hours option (always, once, never)
  - Batch entry of material issues
  - Add scrap factor to material step to allow for shrinkage
- **Improved Multicurrency Support**



# Changes to Delivery and Support

- Standardize on 12-18 month Release Cycle
- Emphasize Current Version
  - Support the current version plus 2 versions back
  - Refine Smart Updates
- Product Updates
  - Every 3-4 months
  - Cumulative product updates (no service packs)
  - Current version only
  - Deliver feature enhancements as well as bug fixes
